



As of June 21st, Trinity Baptist Church moved to phase 2 of our reopening plan, and now offers outdoor worship services!

Services meet every Sunday at 9am, to enjoy God's beautiful creation as we worship, and beat the heat! Chairs are socially distanced, so families from the same household can sit safely together. Masks are required- especially when greeting others before and after the service, and when singing. Cleaning protocols have been put in place for the chairs, and we've made a few other changes to increase safety measures. It's great to be back together again!

The pandemic is still ongoing, and even with our best efforts there are no 100% guarantees that we can stop the virus from impacting us. We encourage you to please consult your medical doctors and CDC recommendations about attending services on the lot. If worshipping in our "outdoor congregation" is not wise for you, we encourage you to participate in our weekly services in other ways. We have live, online services via ZOOM, so don't worry if you are unable to be there physically with us. We even have an option for you to drive to the church and remain in your vehicle while you join us from your car radio! Whatever way you can join us is a blessing!

Trinity's weekly activities remain in "Safer at Home" status. For the time being, Sunday School and Bible studies will continue to connect through phone, email and virtual means. Office staff, deacons, ministers, and volunteers report to the church on an as-needed basis to support food pantry needs and process offerings and continue to tele-work the rest of the time.

Our secretary is in the office on a reduced schedule each Tuesday and Wednesday. Please continue to contact the church via email or by leaving a voice mail for any needs or questions. All our reopening phases will meet or exceed federal, state and local safety requirements.

The final phase will entail a release of all restrictions, with all services and activities able to resume inside the building. We'll enter this phase once the virus is well under control, and appropriate vaccinations and treatments are available. Of course, we expect a bit of a "new normal" in a post-Covid world. We will continue virtual streaming indefinitely, so that church members who are not able to return will still be able to worship with us!

We all look forward to unrestricted worship together again, but if we've learned anything from this experience, it's that the Church is the people, not the building!
